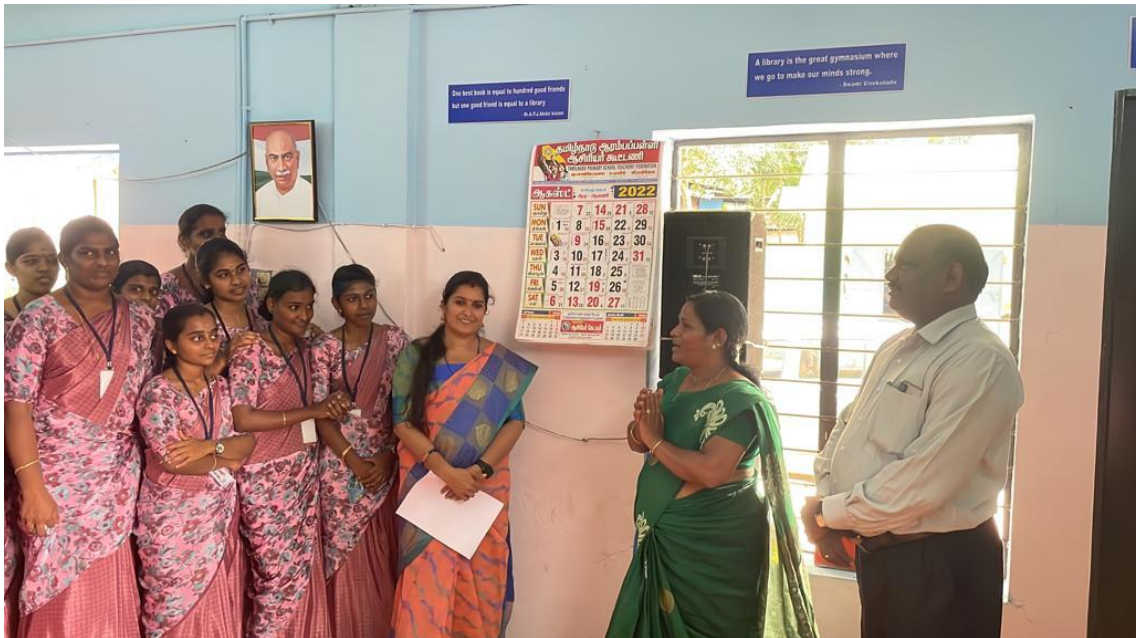

A walkthrough of Koha's user interface was provided to the students by highlighting the key navigation elements and search functionalities. Our students gained experience in navigating Koha's menu.



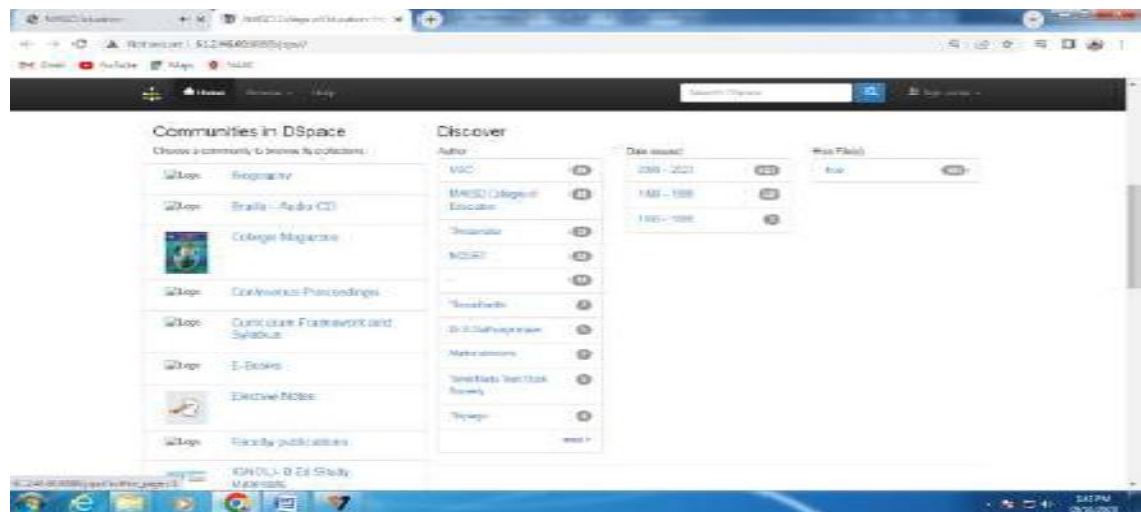
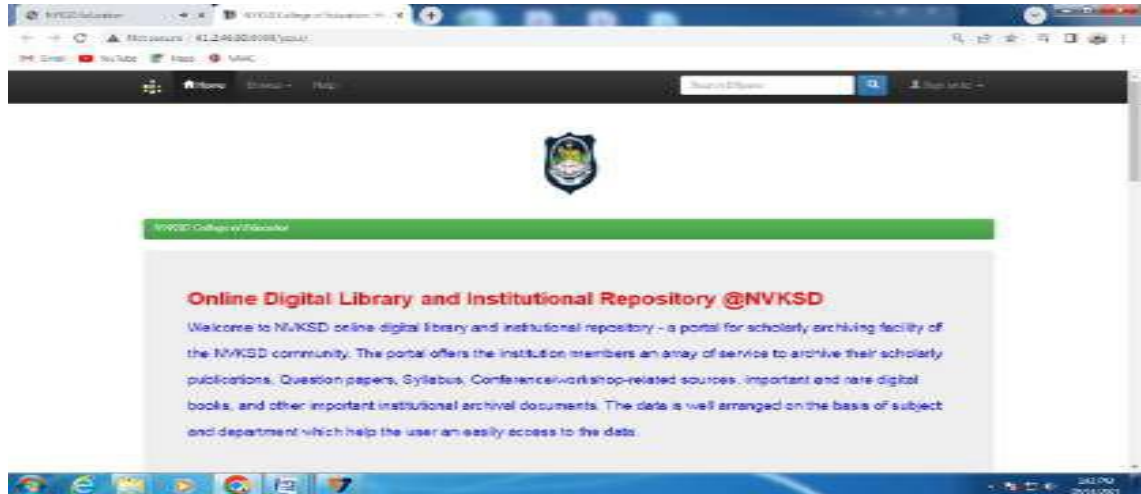
ORIENTATION ON N-LIST

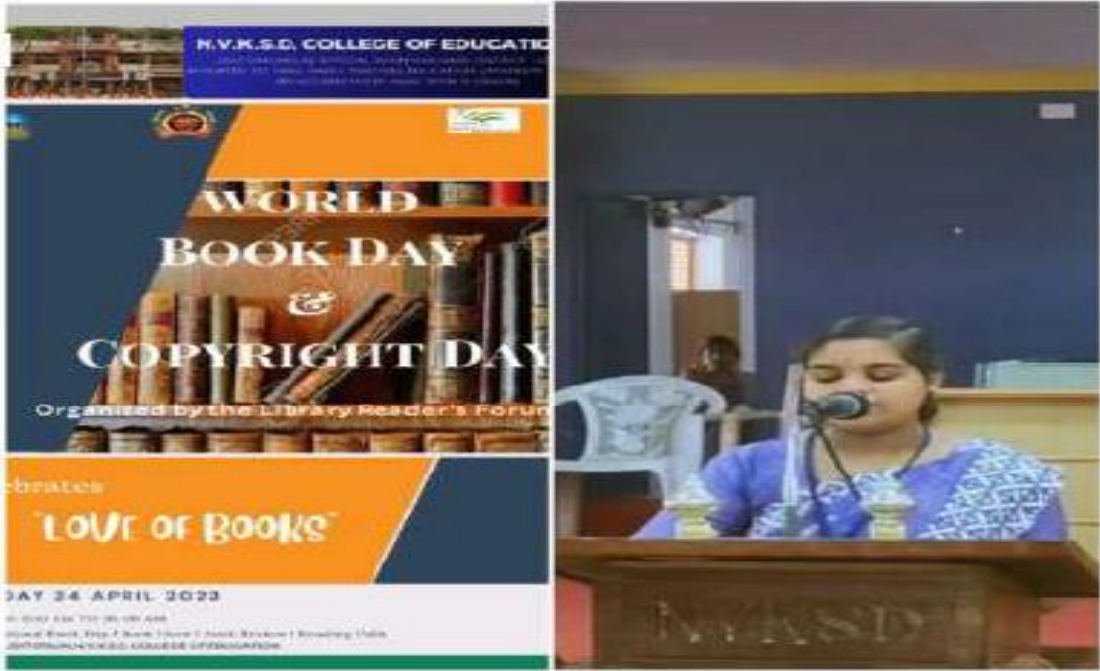
ORIENTATION ON DSPACE

NPTEL FELICITATION AND CERTIFICATION CEREMONY

The institution is offering technologically enhanced learning through the online portal of SWAYAM's National Programme on Technology Enhanced Learning (NPTEL) under the Ministry of Education where our students and staff are opened with the wide possibilities of enrolling themselves into the various courses twice in a year. During the period July- December 2022, 187 members including students and faculty appeared for 13 courses where 6 students were course toppers, 13 got Elite+Gold ranking, 34 got Elite + silver ranking, 66 got Elite ranking and 36 has successfully completed their courses. One of our faculty members achieved the NPTEL Discipline Star award . During the period January-April 2023, 126 members appeared for 9 courses where 4 were Toppers, 14 got Elite + Gold, 21 got Elite + Silver, 41 got Elite ranking and 34 members successfully completed the courses.

The faculty members of the institution are acting as mentors of the students in assisting our students to get through the examinations. The institution has been listed in the 'Active Local Chapter List' based on our excellent performance. SWAYAM- NPTEL Felicitation and Certification Ceremony was held on 2nd May 2023. The course toppers were honoured in the ceremony. Mr. Y. Bibin Das, Assistant Professor of English, St. Jude's College Thoothoor was the Chief Guest.

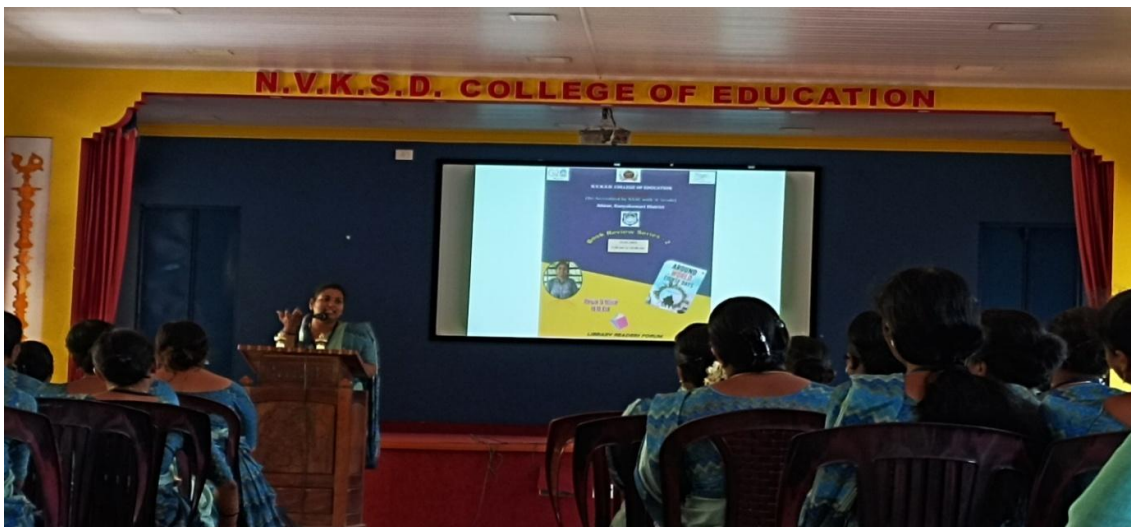
